a. TO DISCUSS THE COMMUNITY CENTRE SITE, INCLUDING REVIEW OF COST IMPLICATIONS AND POTENTIAL FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO ITS USAGE.

Elected Members reviewed the report that had been provided by the Parish Clerk showing running costs and income from the Community Centre in comparison to those from the Village Hall.
